Directions

Our training room is located in the workshop of:

in the large hall on the premises. You will find the entrance on the right side of the workshop.

Directions by car:

Brandenburger Straße is usually accessible from the north and south.

However, the southern bridge will be closed until the end of 2024. Therefore, the road will only be accessible from the north, coming from the direction of Veddeler Damm or Roßdamm. We recommend using Google Maps, as the current road conditions change daily. Luckily, there are many possible routes to reach the destination.

Parking is only available outside the premises. Simply turn right in front of the large access gate. After you pass the railroad tracks, drive onto the car park in front of the HPA office building. Then walk through the large gate to the hall.

Directions by bike:

The bridge closure does not apply to bike riders. So, just follow Google Maps.

Public transport:

- You can take the train to Veddel/Ballinstadt (S3, S5), and then walk for about 20 minutes. To reach your destination, get off at the northern end in Veddel (the platform is on the bridge over the water) and follow the Niedernfelder Ufer (Schwarzer Weg) along the canal to Brandenburger Straße, which is easy to find on Google Maps.
- 2. Take the underground or S-Bahn to Landungsbrücken station. Take the HADAG harbour ferry (line 73) in the direction of Ernst-August-Schleuse (does not run on weekends!), get off at Ernst-August-Schleuse and then walk for about 10 minutes.
