

Requirements for auditors of VPI European Rail Service GmbH for the technical assessment of workshops

- 1. Technical education in the area of metalworking, such as an engineer, technician, master or equivalent professional degrees
- 2. Practical experience in a repair workshop for wagons, as former employee, external quality assurance specialist or similar activity
- 3. At least 3 years professional experience in the application of maintenance guidelines for freight or tank wagons. Experience with the VPI-European Maintenance Guide (VPI-EMG) is preferred. This time can be reduced if training specially adapted to this activity is undertaken.
- 4. At least one successful participation in an education programme / training for welding procedures or non-destructive testing
- 5. Supervised participation in at least 3 complete technical assessments without compensation (before commencing work)
- 6. Participation in an auditor course, with successful completion as at least "internal auditor" as per DIN EN ISO 9001
- 7. Specific knowledge of the maintenance / refurbishing of wheelsets or brake systems is a plus
- Note: Applicants may not be employees of repair workshops and may not reach retirement age within the next 12 months.
